A. December ArtAbout

- Friday, December 9th; Holiday festive theme
- 7 venues participating
- This is the first month with the Davis Dirt back in print and the issue turned out great with a section promoting the December ArtAbout
 - Natalie wants to support The Dirt as they re-launch and continue to work with them
 - Adele Shaw shared the enthusiasm and positive feedback from the community about The Dirt returning to Davis. This is a valuable asset to the art community
- Last month close to 200 people visited the Pence Gallery during ArtAbout.
 Natalie anticipates higher attendance this month as it seems to grow every event
- Natalie, Adele, Brett, and Katelyn to meet to discuss the DDBA's sponsorship of the event and other plans for the event moving into 2023
- Arts Alliance social event review (Yelena)
 - Any artist in Davis has access to free workspaces at the new Olive Drive Davis Coworking space if they go through the Davis Arts Alliance; the City of Davis is funding six months at no charge to local artisans and Arts Alliance members

B. December to Remember (December 1 - 20)

- Kicks off today, December 1st, in coordination with the City of Davis Tree
 Lighting Ceremony
- Elf on The Shelf Scavenger Hunt
 - 10 businesses signed up to participate this year
 - We changed the guidelines for the scavenger hunt this year.
 Instead of taking pictures with all of the elves, the participants will need to take note of the name of each elf they find and message us with their list of names
 - o Winners will be selected to receive gift card prizes
- Window Decorating Contest

- Panel of judges will vote for a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winner
- People's Choice voting is available for the public. QR codes will be posted in business windows to lead people to a form
- Wreath Decorating Contest
 - We have traditional and alternative wreaths for community members to choose from
 - Wreath pickup is today; participants will take the wreaths home over the weekend to decorate and bring them back to the DDBA office on Monday
 - DDBA staff will deliver the wreaths to downtown businesses for them to be hung in storefront windows.
 - The public can vote on their favorite wreath through social media and the winner will receive a prize

 - Annual Board of Director elections will be conducted during the meeting
- 6. Marketing Growth / Trends
 - A. Performance Updates
 - Previous 30 Days: 25 new Facebook page likes and 124 new Instagram followers
 - New growth has slowed down without the Thursdays in The Davisphere events, but we still see growth and engagement
 - We are still getting new subscribers to our newsletter every week, but not nearly at the same rate as during the Thursdays in The Davisphere event series
 - B. Marketing Priority Updates
 - The DDBA website is going to be redesigned/developed. We are working to simplify some of the content and make the site more user friendly
 - Our goal is to have the website completed by the end of March
 - The CRM is being developed; Katelyn Willoughby is working on organizing and updating our membership contacts and streamlining the way we communicate with our members and partners
 - Davis Downtown Gift Card Program Update

- The old gift card system was not working well the few years prior to the pandemic. One of the primary issues was getting the POS systems of participating businesses to work with the gift cards, and another issue was the enormous administrative overhead
- We've identified an egift card program through a service named Yiftee that we are close to finalizing the setup of our account; it should be much easier to use for both the businesses and community members
 - Customers can only use the card for participating DDBA membership businesses (closed circuit)
- More information to come as we finalize the process. We hope to get a soft launch started as soon as possible
