	Mobile Vending Update:
	 Senate Bill 946; State of CA – sidewalk vending must be allowed throughout communities Includes roaming vending in residential areas One year permits Currently no limit State law states that competition cannot be criteria for a permit There is restricted space on our sidewalks - minimum of 5 feet clearance is needed Economic viability Want a vibrant downtown Need a visible permit along with health permit (location, health dept. clearance, etc.) City is proposing to have a sidewalk vendor and food permit Can't vend on turf/dirt/landscaped areas Will it impede on access, parking, etc.? There are zones that are exempt (on private property – they don't need a city vending permit for a short term, single event, etc.) Large number of concerns were addressed City Council public meeting on March 24th to announce the ordinance Request to delay ordinance decision for at least one month for more discussion and understanding amongst business owners

Old Business Davis Downtown Gift Card Program: Suspend the program until further notice; no more sales of new cards but will still honor previously purchased cards at participating businesses reevaluation needed to possibly find a new system that would be better for our downtown and customers (biggest problems being a "closed" system that creates a lot of confusion with customers and vendors, declined cards due to software management, and funds automatically being removed from balance of gift cards not used within certain period of time)
