- c. Considered removing the **5% quorum requirement** due to consistently low turnout; aim to strengthen digital communication instead.
- d. Online/Email voting proposal will be evaluated and brought back at the December meeting.
- e. Ezra will lead a future discussion on outreach requirements for elections and annual meetings.

## 10. Voting & Elections Reform Discussion

- i. Group affirmed the importance of transparent and accessible nomination processes.
- ii. December board meeting will serve as the final deadline for director nominations.
- iii. Target timeline: 21-day notice to members before the January annual meeting.
- iv. Agreement to explore implementing online voting for January's election pending subcommittee recommendation.

#### 11. Neighborhood Market Pilot Review

- a. Brett presented a recap of the October pilot event; response from businesses was positive.
- b. Board voted to allow a second event in January, with future dates requiring formal board approval.
- c. Eric will coordinate with Natalie (Pence Gallery) to identify compatible vendors for potential participation in Second Friday Art About.
- d. Clarification: Neighborhood Market events remain separate from Art About, which will occur 4–6 times per year.
